Third grade:

Make inferences about setting, character traits, and problems/solutions

Identify and explain relevant connections between text to text, text ideas, information and relationships in various fiction and non-fiction works, compare/contrast
Use details to answer questions
4. Develop and apply post-reading strategies:
Use details to answer questions
Demonstrate comprehension
Identify and explain the relationship between the main idea and supporting details
Reflect
5. Read with sufficient accuracy and fluency to support comprehension

Fourth Grade:

1. Develop vocabulary:
 - Using context clues
 - Using synonyms
 - Using antonyms
2. Develop and apply pre-reading strategies:
 - To aid comprehension, predict with evidence
 - Apply information in illustrations, title, chapter headings, etc
3. Develop and apply during and post-reading strategies:
 - Identify cause and effect using details from text
 - Identify and explain examples of sensory details and figurative language
 - Identify and explain examples of sensory details in non-fiction text
 - Use details to make inferences about problem and solutions
4. Read and follow three and four step directions to complete tasks
5. Read with sufficient accuracy and fluency to support comprehension

Fifth Grade:

1. Develop vocabulary:

 - Using glossary and dictionary
2. Develop and apply pre-reading strategies:
 - Make inferences about setting, character traits, problem/solution, and story events
3. Develop and apply during-reading strategies:
 - Identify and explain examples of literary techniques- personification
 - Apply information in text features and graphics to clarify and connect concepts to the main idea
4. Develop and apply post-reading strategies:
 - Utilize strategies to paraphrase, draw conclusions, summarize, compare/contrast, cause/effect,
 - Identify and explain the relationship between the main idea and supporting details
5. Read and follow multi-step directions to complete a task
6. Read with sufficient accuracy and fluency to support comprehension

Sixth Grade:

Demonstrate comprehension by using details from the text to among many things: state Author's ideas, compare and contrast, sequence events and evaluate information/effectiveness of solutions
